



Protocols for Spectators Attending Beach District Football Games This Season

Due to the Governor's Executive Order #72, a maximum of 250 spectators will be permitted to attend high school football games this season. Each player will receive an allotment of tickets each week to be given to guests of their choice.

Those attending football games this season need to be aware of the following protocols in place to ensure a safer experience.

- Spectators should not attend if they have experienced:
 - A fever or temperature higher than 100.4 degrees in the past 72 hours prior to the game.
 - A new cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills and/or body shaking
 - A new sore throat
 - A change in the senses of smell/taste
 - Headache
 - Muscle or body aches
 - A close contact with anyone who has been sick with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Only spectators with a valid ticket will be permitted to enter the stadium. Others without a ticket will be required to exit the school grounds.
- Spectators will be subject to screening, which may include the use of a walk-through metal detector.
- Spectators must wear a face covering at all times while on school property.
- Spectators will need to be seated in the bleachers, appropriately distanced at least 6' from others who do not live in the same household.
- Concession stands will not be open during football games.
- Tailgating in the parking lot will not be permitted.
- Spectators will exit the school grounds after the conclusion of the game.
